DOCUMENTS NEEDED FOR REGISTRATION APPLICATION:-

1. Description of the Work: - Literary, Artistic, dramatic or musical.
2. Name and Address of the Applicant
3. Name and Address of the Artist/Author. And Nationality.
4. Title of the work to be registered, Language of the work.
5. Whether work is published or unpublished.
6. Year and country of first publication and names, address and nationality of the publishers.
7. Years and countries of subsequent publications, if any and names addresses and nationalities of the publishers.
8. Names, address and nationalities of the owners of the various rights comprising the copyright in the work and the extent of the rights held by each together with the particulars of assignments and licenses if any.
9. Names, addresses and nationalities of other persons if any authorized to sign or license the rights comprising the copyright.
10. Whether The work to be registered :
 - (a) An original work? or
 - (b) A translation of a work in the public domain? or
 - (c) An adaption of a work in which copyright subsists? or
 - (d) An adaption of a work in the public domain? or
 - (e) An adaption of a work in which copyright subsists?
11. Five copies of the work
12. Power of Attorney in our favour. (No need of legalization).

TRADEMARK-

DOCUMENTS NEEDED FOR SEARCH:-

WORD, LABEL, TICKED, BRAND FOR WHICH SEARCH IS REQUIRED.

Registration of Trademarks:-

Search for the Name, Device, logo, Label intended to be applied as Trademark.

Apply for registration of Trademark.

1. Examination of application by the department and issue of the examination report raising objections under
2. Different Sections of the Act or accepting the mark to be advertised.
3. Replying to the official objections and ask for hearing if required.
4. In hearing put up all evidence in support of trademark application.
5. Getting the order for trademark to be advertised, the advertisement is done in the Official gazette called Trademark Journal and is available to any member of the public to oppose the application with in 4 months of the date of the publication.

If no opposition is received or opposition is decided in favour of the applicant, a certificate of Registration is issued which is valid for ten years and after that renewable for every ten years on the payment of renewal fees.

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR THE REGISTRATION OF A DESIGN

1. Name of the Article.
2. Five Copies each of the photographs of the Article from each side like Front View, Back view, Side View, The other side view, Perspective view or other possible view.
3. Name of the applicant
4. Name of the Partners/Directors
5. Office address.
6. Trade description:- Whether Manufacturer / Merchants / Both.
7. In case of an earlier application in convention country then priority documents.
8. Power of Attorney in our favour. (no need of legalization) - language given below:-

Right on registration:-

When a design is registered, the registered proprietor of the design shall, have copyright in the design during ten years from the date of registration.

Renewal

If, before the expiration of the said ten years, application for the extension of the period of copyright is made to the Controller in the prescribed manner, the Controller shall, on payment of the prescribed fee, extend the period of copy-right for a second period of five years from the expiration of the original period of ten years.

PATENT REGISTRATION:

BASIC REQUIREMENTS TO ENTER NATIONAL PHASE IN INDIA

Under the said basic requirements to start the national phase in India, the applicant is required to file the following with the DO/IN (Designated office) or EO/IN (Elected office) within the prescribed time limit:-

1. An application on a plain paper (Form 1 may be used, however the option remains with the applicant);
2. National fee.

As per DO/IN or EO/IN the special requirements of the Office are as follows:

- Name, Nationality and address of the inventor if they have not been furnished in the "Request" part of the international application,
- Instrument of assignment or transfer where the applicant is not the inventor,
- Document evidencing a change of name of the applicant if the change occurred after the international filing date and has not been reflected in a notification from the International Bureau (Form PCT/IB/306). Form 6 and/or Form 13 is also required.
- Declaration of inventorship by the applicant,
- Statement regarding filing of corresponding applications in other countries,
- Power of attorney if an agent is appointed,
- Address for service in India (but representation by an agent is not a must)
- Verification of translation, and
- Copy of International application or its translation
- And other / more...

LLP REGISTRATION-

FORMATION OF LIMITED LIABILITY PARTNERSHIP:-

1. Take Digital Signature for any of the Designated Partners
2. Applying for Designated Partners Identification Number in Form 7 for each partner.
3. Applying for the name approval by filling and filing of the Form 1.
4. File Form2 the form for incorporation and pay the registration fees. If approved, your

LLP is formed and you will get the incorporation certificate FOR EXAMPLE "X&Y LLP" .

5. Now scan and submit the agreement between the Partners with the Registrar.
